## Pearl White Carpathian Harebell



An improvement on the older 'Clips' series with larger blooms. Plants form a low, cushionshaped mound of small green leaves, with loads of upfacing, open bells appearing in early summer. This selection has clear white flowers. Will continue blooming for weeks if spent blossoms are regularly removed. Excellent choice for the rock garden, edging and in containers.





## Campanula carpatica 'Pearl White'

- <u>Use:</u> A favorite perennial for rock gardens. Prepared to flower heavily right through summer, this small plant adds a lot of charm to the perennial garden, woodland, and rockery!
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Prefers full—part sun. Prefers cooler summer nights so some afternoon shade is beneficial. Water when top 3" of soil is dry. Looks lovely outside on the patio in planter.
- Growth: Grows to 8-12in. tall, spreads to 10-18" wide.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 5-10; Perennial.
- Foliage: Deciduous. The dark green wavy foliage is dainty.
- <u>Flower:</u> Produces tons of 2" cup-shaped, white flowers on top a low cushion mound of green leaves with wavy edges, drought tolerant, deadhead for continuous bloom.
