**Location:** park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, ecological zone, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant, Eco planting

**Height:** 0.25 - 0.6 m | **Width:** 0.4 - 0.6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9B

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** tolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (5.5 - 6.8) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to salt spray, tolerates air pollution

**Flowers:** panicle, corymbose, striking | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** June - July | **Leaf colour:** green, dark green | **Leaves:** evergreen, lanceolate, narrow | **Fruits:** striking, capsules | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Twig colour:** green | **Twigs:** hairy | **Root system:** compact
